

The State of Higher Ed Teaching: *Insights from the Field*



Educators are adapting to evolving student needs and intensifying workloads. DigitalEd's **2025 Higher Ed Trends Report**, which surveyed 350+ educators globally, revealed some key insights on how educators are navigating this evolving landscape, from integrating new technologies to addressing changing student behaviors.



Workload Pressures:

Educators are grappling with increased responsibilities, including addressing learning gaps, managing technology, and providing student support. Educators shared they are carrying heavier workloads, with one instructor noting, *"I am tracking attendance for all classes and reporting grades to Student Success multiple times during the semester. I email students who have submitted assignments. I offer multiple dates for most exams. I am doing mental health check-ins and reporting students with financial issues."* This highlights the need for institutional support, streamlined workflows, and a reassessment of faculty workload allocation.



Resourcefulness:

50% of educators said they use a combination of sources (online learning platforms and textbooks) to create lessons, assignments, quizzes, and tests and often create their own resources (26%).

64% of educators said that they rely on their LMS to structure course content and assessments.
